Vital Elements to Create a Healthy Life Giving Church:

A. Have a clear compelling vision, ends and mission that is real and shapes ministry. *The KEY*: Do it, speak about it, share stories, and celebrate it weekly for YEARS!!

- 1. Vision where you are going. A picture of a preferred future.

 A catalytic force to bless Southern Arizona and strategic parts of the world.
- 2. Ends the main paths that will get you to your vision. These shape programming, budgeting, marketing, and staffing.
 - a. Every participant following Jesus well.
 - b. Reaching people not currently connected to God or a church community.
 - c. Multiplying healthy life-giving churches.
 - d. Developing healthy communities within neighborhoods and villages.
- 3. Mission what your people do to get to your vision.

 Loving people to Jesus, launching passionate people to make a difference.
- B. A healthy leadership system that is pastor (staff) led and elder (board) protected utilizing policy governance.
